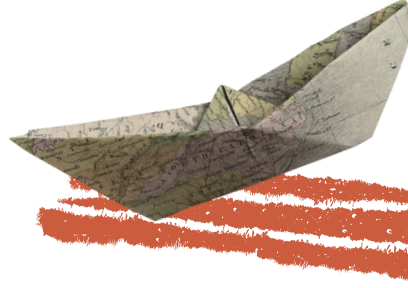


Our student exchange program with Ishwarpuram students, (Tulapur) was an incredible experience!
